

Tribal Energy FOA deadline extended

The application deadline for the Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Deployment in Indian Country FOA has been extended to April 30, 2009 and amended with new application submittal instructions. Applications will NOT be accepted through Grants.gov or IIPS for this announcement. Applicants must now submit their applications through the [EERE Project Management Center](#).

1. Installation of efficiency improvements to existing tribally owned buildings – including energy efficiency upgrades and renewable energy systems for building heating or cooling,
2. Preconstruction activities for renewable energy projects, and
3. Construction of renewable energy systems for power production.
